Procedures are continuing for the implementation of the 1st Meeting of the UNAI Hubs for the Sustainable Development Goals (UNAI SDGs Hubs), as these are included in the "2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development". The meeting will take place during the 41st week of 2024 (Oct. 7-11, 2024) in Athens.

The "Agenda" is the action plan on which the 193 member states of the UN agreed in 2015. It is the plan that, through the efforts to achieve the 169 individual goals, it seeks to strengthen global peace, with greater freedom for people.

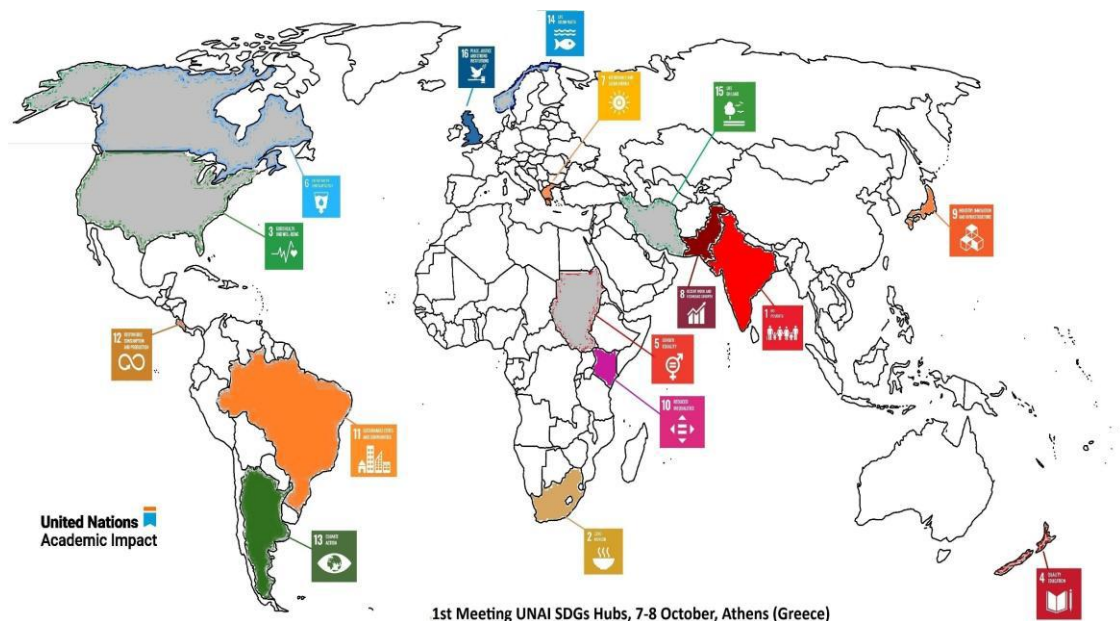
